**THE GEMINI**

- 4 ounces fresh grapefruit juice, strained
- 3 ounces St-Germain liqueur
- 2 ounces vodka
- Ice cubes
- Prosecco
- 2 grapefruit-rind twists

**MIX** grapefruit juice, St-Germain, vodka, and ice in a cocktail shaker. Shake and strain into 2 chilled glasses. Top each with Prosecco.

**SERVE** each with a grapefruit twist. Makes 2
